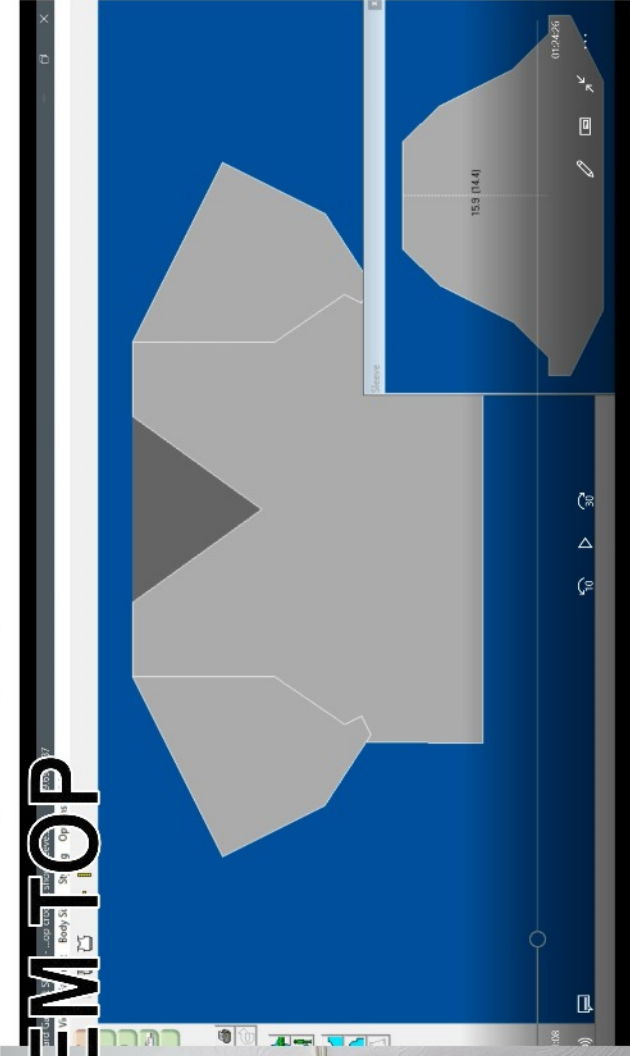

# HANKY HEM TOP

# MATERIALS NEEDED

3MM Crochet Hook

Sewing Machine

A pair of Scissors

800 Grams Double Knit(DK) Yarn, 100% Acrylic

Sewing Pins

Sewing Thread to co-ordinate yarn

Crochet Stitch Gauge or Tension Swatch-

**Main Tensions      5.00 Stitches & 2.00 Rows per inch**

Garment type :Sweater

Sleeve type :Set-in

Neck style - front :Vee

Neck style - back :Straight

To fit Chest : 36.2 inches + ease 3.9 inches

To fit Waist or hip : 38.2 inches + ease 2.0 inches

To fit Nape to garment length : 15.0 inches + ease 0.0 inches

To fit Arm length : 8.0 inches + ease 0.0 inches

To fit Upper arm : 11.6 inches + ease 3.9 inches

To fit Wrist : 6.5 inches + ease 3.3 inches

To fit Shoulder to shoulder : 14.0 inches + ease 0.4 inches

To fit Arm hole depth : 8.5 inches + ease 0.6 inches

Main Tensions 5.00 Stitches & 2.00 Rows per inch

Welt, Cuff, and Neckband Tensions 5.00 Stitches & 2.00 Rows per inch

Tension dial setting or needle sizes - 3mm Crochet Hook

Double Crochet -dc UK

# **ABBREVIATION**

**DC = double crochet. (UK terms)**

**CH = chain**

## BACK

Crochet hanky hem top crochet short sleeve / (100s x 30r)

Make 101 chain

R1: Make 1 double crochet into 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook , 1dc into each chain space across(100 dc made), 1 turning chain.

R2: 1dc into 100 dc in previous row, 1 turning chain.

Rows 3-10:Repeat rows 2.

R11: 100.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R12: DC 96.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R13: DC 92.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R14: DC 88.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R15: DC 84.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R16: DC 81.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R17: DC 78.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R18: DC 75.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R19: DC 72.

R20: DC 72.

Rows 21-30: Repeat rows 19 & 20 (without the shaping).

Cast off remainder. End of piece.

# FRONT

Crochet hanky hem top crochet short sleeve / (100s x 30r)

Make 101 chain

R1: Make 1 double crochet into 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook , 1dc into each chain space across(100 dc made), 1 turning chain.

R2: 1dc into 100 dc in previous row, 1 turning chain.

Rows 3-10: Repeat rows 2.

R11: DC 100.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R12: DC 96.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R13: DC 92.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R14: DC 88.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R15: DC 84.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R16: DC 81.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R17: DC 78.

When knitting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R18: DC 75.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R19: DC 72.

When crocheting the next row: Hold 36.

R20: DC 36.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R21: DC 32.

R22: DC 32.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R23: DC 28.

R24: DC 28.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R25: DC 24.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

Cast off remainder.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R26: DC 24.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R28: DC 20.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R30: DC 16.

Cast off remainder. End of piece.

# LEFT SLEEVE

crochet hanky hem top crochet short sleeve / (78s x 17r)

Make 49 chain.

R1: Make 1 double crochet into 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 dc into each chain space across (48 dc made).

When crocheting the next row: Inc 15 sts at start.

R2: DC 63.

When crocheting the next row: Inc 15 sts at start.

R3: DC 78.

R4: DC 78.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R5: DC 74.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R6: DC 70.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R7: DC 66.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 8 sts at start.

R8: DC 58.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R9: DC 54.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 2 sts at start.

R10: DC 52.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R11: DC 48.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R12: DC 45.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

## LEFT SLEEVE CONTINUES -1

R13: DC 41.

# SLEEVE RIGHT

crochet hanky hem top crochet short sleeve / (78s x 17r)

Make 49 chain.

R1: Make 1 double crochet into 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 dc into each chain space across (48 dc made).

When crocheting the next row: Inc 15 sts at start.

R2: DC 63.

When crocheting the next row: Inc 15 sts at start.

R3: DC 78.

R4: DC 78.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R5: DC 74.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R6: DC 70.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R7: DC 66.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 8 sts at start.

R8: DC 58.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R9: DC 54.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 2 sts at start.

R10: DC 52.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

R11: DC 48.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R12: DC 45.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 4 sts at start.

## **RIGHT SLEEVE CONTINUES -1**

R13: DC 41.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 3 sts at start.

R14: DC 38.

When crocheting the next row: Dec 8 sts at start.

R15: DC 30.

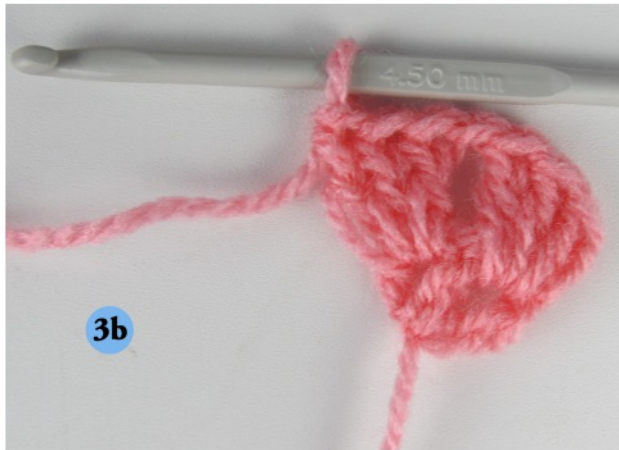
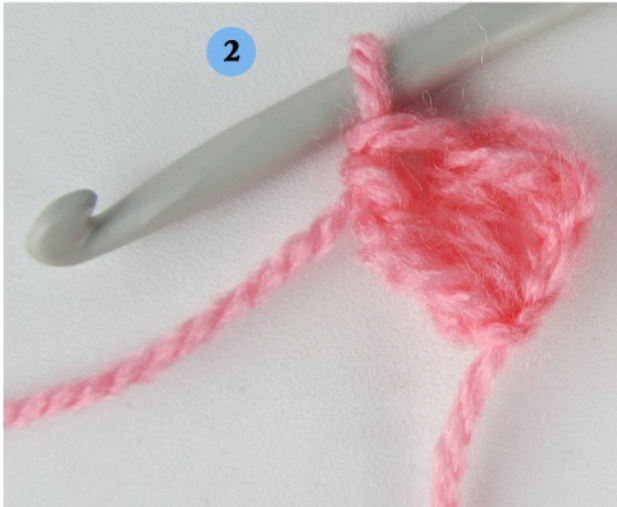
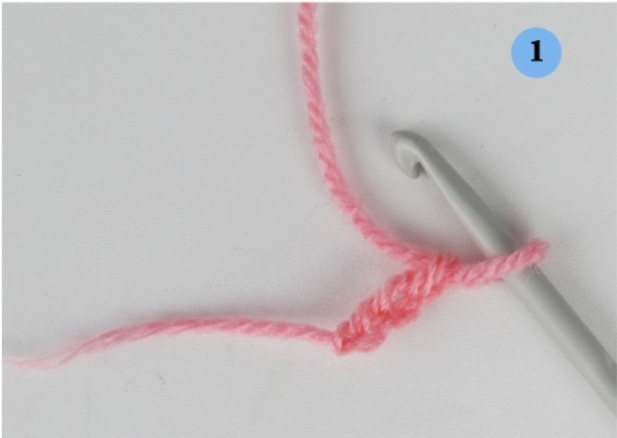
When crocheting the next row: Dec 8 sts at start.

# CROCHET TRIANGLES FOR HANKY HEM (Make 4)

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Abbreviation

**DC = double crochet.**

**CH = chain**

**Row 1:** Holding 1 strand of yarn, make 3 CH.

**Row 2:** 2 dc into first ch space and then 1 ch, 3dc into next ch space.

**Row 3:** 1 ch, 3 dc into first space and then 1 ch, 3dc into the next space.

**Row 4:** 1ch, 3 dc into the space between the last two dc of the previous row.  
1 ch, 3dc into ch space of previous row and then 1 ch 3 dc into the space between the first two dcs of the previous row.

**Row 5:** Continue in this pattern until you have reached desired length and width.  
( I made 30 rows).

Cast off.

Weave in loose ends.

## FINISHING

Sew the back shoulders of the bodice to the front shoulders of the bodice.

Sew the sleeves to the bodice. Sew the sides of the bodice.

Pin the crochet triangles pieces to the hem of the bodice and then sew.

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
